LEGION AUXILIARY AMERICANISM ESSAY CONTEST

Each year, the American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) sponsors an Americanism Essay Contest for students in grades 3-12, including students with special needs. Grade levels are divided into six classes. One award in each of the six classes will be presented in each division. Winners will receive \$50 and a \$50 donation in the student's name will be made to the Children of Warriors National Presidents' Scholarship fund. National winners will be posted at www.ALAforVeterans.org after convention. There is a new topic every year, decided upon by the New National President – and published in September. SD LEGION AUXILIARY AMERICANISM POEM CONTEST

Each year, the South Dakota American Legion Auxiliary conducts a poem contest based on the current year Department President's theme. This contest is unique to our Department and there is no National Poem contest. There are 5 classes, 3rd through 6th grades and the Developmentally Disabled. LEGION AUXILIARY POPPY POSTER CONTEST

The South Dakota American Legion Auxiliary also sponsors a poppy poster contest in local schools. The contest can have seven classes: Class I: Grades 2 and 3, Class II: Grades 4 and 5, Class III: Grades 6 and 7, Class IV: Grades 8 and 9, Class V: Grades 10 and 11, Class VI: Grade 12, and Class VII: Students with special needs. DEPARTMENT OF SOUTH DAKOTA AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIPS:

- THELMA FOSTER SCHOLARSHIP FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS \$300. Candidate must be a paid Auxiliary member for the past 3 years and hold a current year membership card. Must be a senior in high school.
- THELMA FOSTER SCHOLARSHIP FOR SENIOR MEMBERS \$300. Candidate must be a paid Auxiliary member for the past 3 years and hold a current year membership card.
- **SENIOR MEMBERS SCHOLARSHIP** \$400. Candidate must be a paid Auxiliary member for the past 3 years and hold a current year membership card. Must demonstrate financial need.
- SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL Two \$500 for each University and Technical Schools. Applicant must be the child or grandchild of a veteran or Auxiliary member. Must be between 16 and 22 years of age and show financial need.

- CHILDREN OF WARRIORS NATIONAL PRESIDENTS' SCHOLARSHIP Three \$5000 scholarships awarded in each division. Awarded to children of Legion-eligible veterans. The applicant must complete 50 hours of community service during his/her high school years and be a senior in high school.
- NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP One \$2000 scholarship will be awarded in each division. The applicant must be a member of the Legion, Auxiliary, or Sons for the two preceding years as well as be a currently paid member. Nontraditional is defined as a student who has returned to the classroom after a period of time where their education was interrupted or someone who is beginning their educational career at a later point in their life.
- **SPIRIT OF YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP** One Junior Auxiliary Member in each division will receive \$1250 per year for four years (\$5000). The applicant must be a member of the Auxiliary for the past three consecutive years and hold a current paid membership card and agree to continue her membership during the four-year scholarship period. Applicant must be a senior in high school with a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- JUNIOR MEMBER LOYALTY SCHOLARSHIP Two Junior Auxiliary Members in each division will each receive a \$2500 scholarship. The applicant must be a member of the Auxiliary for three consecutive years and hold a current paid membership card and continue her membership during the four-year scholarship period. This scholarship is meant for the traditional student who has finished at least 1 semester of coursework and is working towards their degree but has not yet attained her bachelor's degree. A minimum 3.0 GPA is required.
