A committee has been established to administer the selection from among those seniors graduating from Sioux Falls High Schools who are about to enter college.

Applications and all related supporting documents must be post marked no later than **March 15<sup>th</sup>** for consideration for the next academic school year and be returned to:

All interested graduating seniors are encouraged to apply for this scholarship.

The committee will select scholarship recipients based upon grade point average, financial need, extracurricular activities, abilities and character. The “whole student” is taken into consideration based upon the written application form, the family’s most recent IRS Form 1040 tax return, letters of recommendation and high school transcript.

The scholarship committee generally makes its selection of recipients and notifies them by early May. Scholarship funds are paid in full to the student’s residency and local laws. Recipients should consult their individual tax advisor/preparer on any tax related questions.
