STATE LEVEL SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

SD American Legion Educational Scholarship – Applicant must be a veteran or children/grandchildren of Veterans who are current members in the American Legion or are deceased and must be a high school graduate with at least 16 hours of post-secondary credits. A maximum of \$2500 will be awarded to any one student so more students can receive assistance and is based on available funds. See brochure at the link above for additional information. **Deadline:** 11:59pm February 15th, current year. <u>Chandler L. Beach Memorial Spirit of Boys State Award</u> – A \$500 scholarship will go to the Boys Stater who best exemplifies the purpose of American Legion Boys State of South Dakota. No separate application – is chosen by the Boys State Staff. <u>https://www.sdlegion.org/boys-state/</u>

<u>Youth Trooper Academy Outstanding Graduate Scholarship</u> – A \$500 scholarship will go the most outstanding recruit, as chosen by the Public Safety Committee – no separate application. <u>SD American Legion Baseball Scholarship</u> – Must have graduated from high school, be on a current roster filed with National Headquarters, be part of a team affiliated with an American Legion post. NATIONAL LEVEL SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

<u>American Legion Legacy Scholarship</u> - Children of U.S. military members who died while on active duty on or after Sept. 11, 2001 or children of post-9/11 veterans having been assigned a combined disability rating of 50 percent or greater by the Department of Veterans Affairs also qualify. Each needs-based scholarship provides up to \$20,000 in aid for undergraduate or post-graduate college. Recipients may reapply for additional annual awards up to six times. **Deadline** is April 1st. <u>https://www.legion.org/scholarships/legacy</u>

<u>American Legion Baseball Scholarship</u> - Eight players selected by a scholarship selection committee at The American Legion World Series will receive a \$2,500 scholarship. A ninth player, selected as the most outstanding member of the All-Academic Team, will be awarded a \$5,000 scholarship. Must be a high school graduate. **Deadline** is July 15th, current year, to your state headquarters. <u>https://www.legion.org/scholarships/baseball</u>

Samsung American Legion Scholarship - American Legion Boys State or American Legion Auxiliary Girls State program participants. Ten national scholars receive \$10,000 each (two from each region), ten national runners-up receive \$5,000 each (two from each region), and remaining department finalists receive \$1,250 each guaranteed. **Deadline:** prior to 11:59 (local time) of Day 1 of their respective American Legion Boys State or American Legion Auxiliary Girls State program. National High School Oratorical Contest Scholarship - Scholarships are awarded to the three finalists. First place receives \$25,000, second gets \$22,500 and third takes \$20,000. Each individual state winner certified into and participating in the first round of the national contest receives a \$2,000 scholarship. Each first-round winner who advances but does not qualify for the finals receives an additional \$2,000 scholarship. No application.
